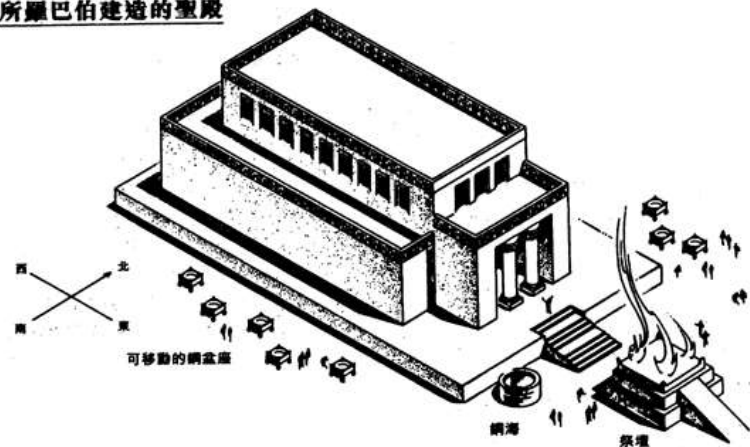

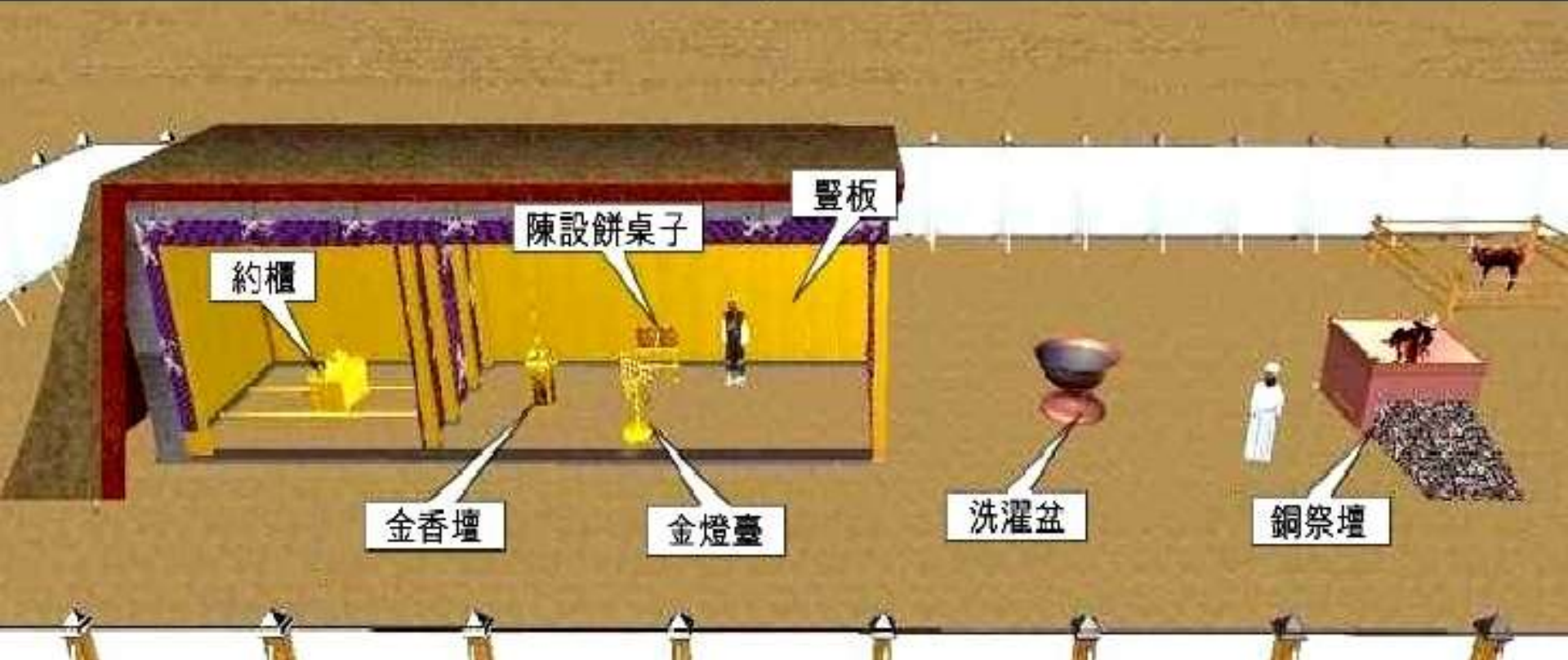
- 在**建造圣殿**的史册中，没有一座圣殿的建造是由一个人或者几个人完成的。

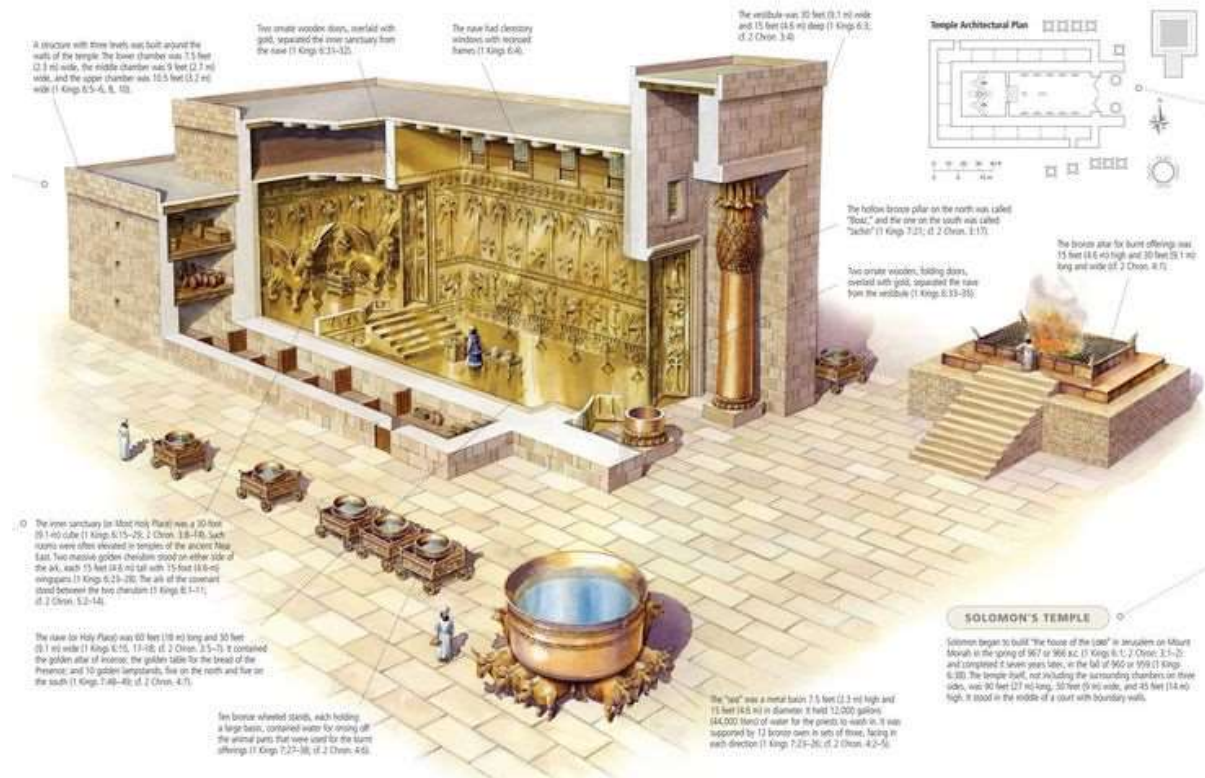

David builds the temple

历代志上 1 Chronicles 22:1-3

- “他吩咐聚集住以色列地的外邦人，从其中派石匠凿石头……预备许多铁，作门上的钉子和钩子；又预备许多铜，多得无法可称；又预备无数的香柏木，因为西顿人和推罗人给大卫运了许多香柏木来。”
- Then David said, "The house of the LORD God is to be here, and also the altar of burnt offering for Israel." So David gave orders to assemble the aliens living in Israel, and from among them he appointed stonecutters to prepare dressed stone for building the house of God. He provided a large amount of iron to make nails for the doors of the gateways and for the fittings, and more bronze than could be weighed.



- 所罗门建造圣殿时，“他就挑选七万扛抬的、八万在山上凿石头的，三千六百督工的。He conscripted seventy thousand men as carriers and eighty thousand as stonecutters in the hills and thirty-six hundred as foremen over them. **(历代志下 1 Chronicles 2:2)**

以斯拉记 Ezra 3: 2-6



以斯拉教导以色列民起来建筑以色列神的坛，并在坛上向耶和华献燔祭、甘心祭，守住棚节，心里尊主为大，对神信靠顺服，并充满感恩赞美。

Ezra taught the people of Israel to rise up and build the altar of the God of Israel, and to offer burnt offerings and sweet offerings to the Lord on the altar, to keep the Feast of Tabernacles, to honour the Lord in their hearts, to trust and obey Him, and to be filled with thanksgiving and praise.

Building a spiritual life before building a temple

Building a spiritual life before building a temple

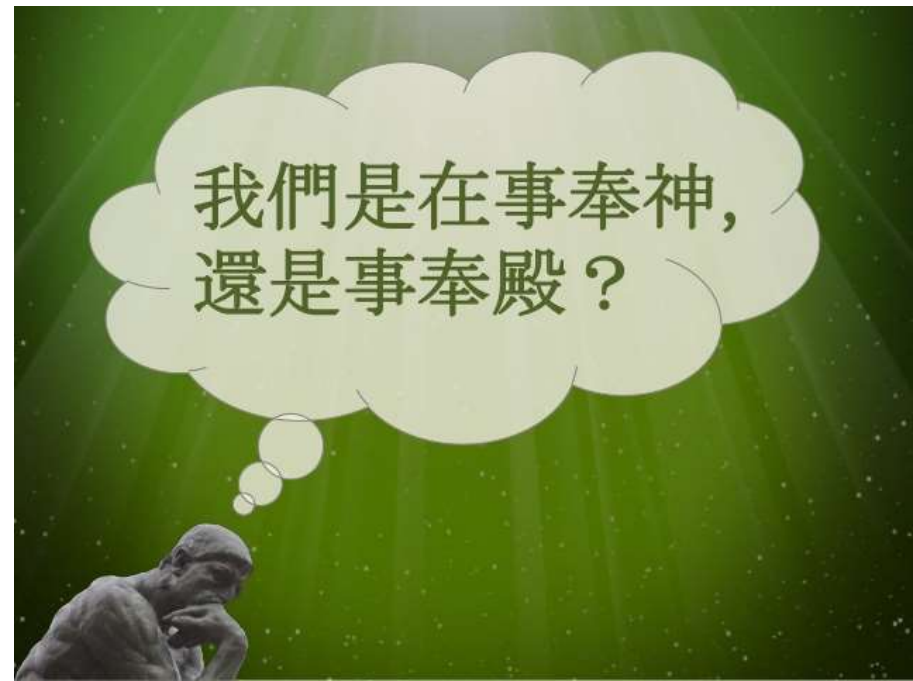

- **Who we are is more important than what we do. Only when we are pleasing to God can we build the Lord's church, and what we do counts.**

Building a spiritual life before building a temple

To give oneself to God is not to work for God, but to let God work, and whoever does not allow God to work cannot work for God.

Building a spiritual life before building a temple

- **建殿的工作不是人发起的，也不是人成就的，建造圣殿是神自己的工作。**
- The work of building temples is not initiated or accomplished by man, but the construction of temples is God's own work.

- God is the initiator, and He is the Achiever, and God is strengthening His own work.

Building a spiritual life before building a temple

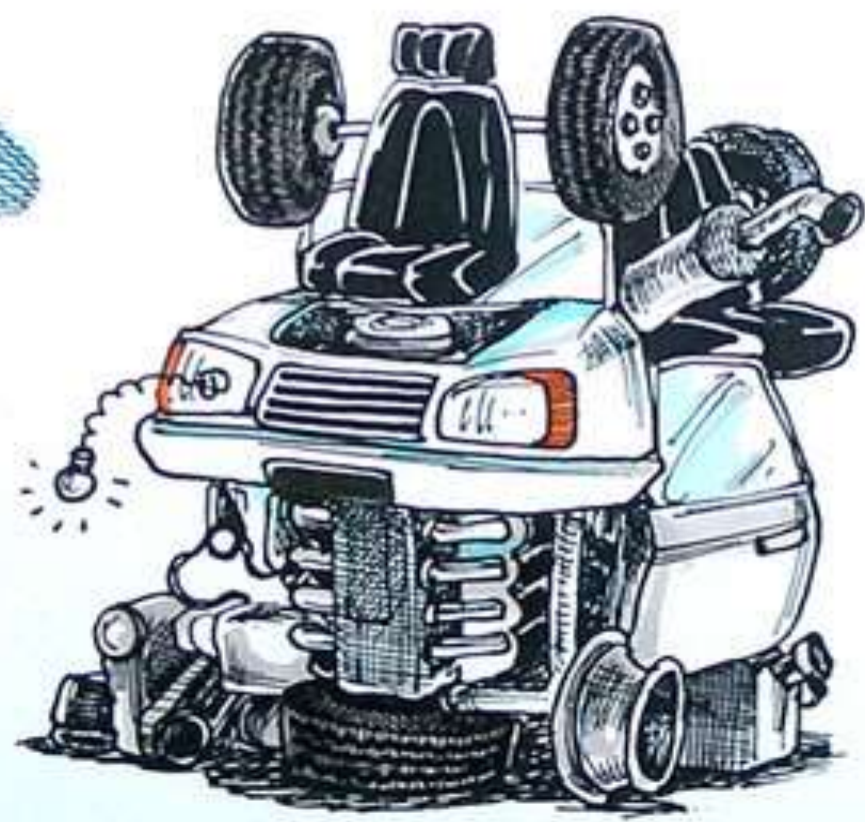
