#### 一、爱神律法的人有福了

Blessed are those who love God's law

"惟喜爱耶和华的律法,昼夜思想,这人便为有福!"(诗 Psalms

1:2) But his delight is in the law of the LORD, and on his law he meditates day and night.

Blessed are those who turn to the true God

Blessed are all who take refuge in him.

**Psalms 94:12)** Blessed is the man you discipline, O LORD, the man you teach from your law;





这首32篇"悔罪诗"可能是诗篇第51篇的续集。This Psalm32 "Penitential psalm" is probably a sequel to Psalm 51.

这首32篇是一首感恩的诗。 This 32 is a psalm of thanksgiving.

The blessing of forgiveness of sins (1 - 2)

1节: 「得赦免其过,<u>遮盖</u>其罪的, 这人是有福的。」 Blessed is he whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.



遮掩自己罪过的,必不亨通; 承认离弃罪过的,必蒙怜恤。

He who conceals his sins does not prosper, but whoever confesses and renounces them finds mercy. (Proverbs 28:13)

The blessing of forgiveness of sins (1-2)

1节: 「得赦免其过, 遮盖其罪的, 这人是有福的。」 Blessed is he whose transgressions are forgiven, whose sins are covered.

2节: 「凡心里没有诡诈,耶和华不算为有罪的,这人是有福的。」 Blessed is the man whose sin the LORD does not count against him and in whose spirit is no deceit.

The blessing of forgiveness of sins (1-2)

#### 诗 Psalms 103:8-12




3节: 我闭口不认罪的时候, 因终日唉哼而骨头枯干。When I kept silent, my bones wasted away through my groaning all day long.

# 自古以来多少人的失败,不就是由于不懂得控制自己所引起的吗?


Since ancient times, how many people's failure is not caused by not knowing how to control themselves?

5节: 「我向你陈明我的罪,不隐瞒我的恶。我说: "我要向耶和华承认我的恶。我说: "我要向耶和华承认我的过犯。"你就赦免我的罪恶。」
Then I acknowledged my sin to you and did not cover up my iniquity. I said, "I will confess my transgressions to the LORD"--and you forgave the guilt of my sin.





If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)



6节: 「为此,凡虔诚人都当<mark>趁你可</mark>寻找的时候祷告你,大水泛滥的时候,少不能到他那里。」 Therefore let everyone who is godly pray to you while you may be found; surely when the mighty waters rise, they will not reach him.

I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you.

The resolution to leave sin (8-11)

9节: 「你不可像那无知的骡马,必用嚼环辔知的骡马,必用嚼环络,外勒住他,不然,就不能驯服。」

Do not be like the horse or the mule, which have no understanding but must be controlled by bit and bridle or they will not come to you.

10-11节: 「恶人必多受苦楚,惟独倚靠耶和华的,必有<mark>慈爱四面环绕</mark>他。你们义人应当靠耶和华<mark>欢喜快</mark>乐. 你们心里正直的人都应当<mark>欢呼</mark>。

Many are the woes of the wicked, but the Lord's unfailing love surrounds the one who trusts in him. Rejoice in the Lord and be glad, you righteous; sing, all you who are upright in heart!


