



" ...to love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your strength, and all your mind."





"You have answered correctly," Jesus replied. "Do this and you will live."But he wanted to justify himself, so he asked Jesus, "And who is my neighbor?"







#### 聖地東西橫截面





































I will love others with the love that God has loved me

- Samaritan: Actual Action Unconditional Love

- His attitude is not "Who is my neighbor?" His attitude is "Who can I be a neighbor to? I can be a neighbor to him (the wounded person)."







- 4)有持续性的 Sustained




