


41-42节

旧约 Old Testament

民数记 14:5

- · 摩西亚伦就俯伏在以色列全会众面前
- Then Moses and Aaron fell facedown in front of the whole Israelite assembly gathered there.

指以色列民的聚会, "耶和华的会", "会众" The assembly of the children of Israel, "The congregation of the Lord", "the assembly of the people"

新约 New Testament

马太福音 16:18

- 我要把我的教会建造在这磐石上, 阴间的权柄不能胜过他
- I will build my church, and the gates of Hades will not overcome it

指招聚,「群体」,「会众」 "to assemble", "assembly", "congregation"

- · 旧约: 所有顺服神的人都是这群体的一份子
- Old Testament: All those who obey God are part of this congregation



- •新约: 信靠耶稣基督的基督徒
- New Testament: Christians who trust in Jesus Christ



- · 教会就是神拣选出来的一群人,是过去、现在和将来属于神的一群人
- The church is a group of people chosen by God, belonging to God in the past, present, and future



- · 教会是信徒的团体, 是神的子民以团契的 方式生活在一起
- The church is a community of believers, living together in fellowship as God's people



- ·<mark>神</mark>在教会中工作,但教会不是<mark>神</mark>。
- <mark>神</mark>是创造者,教会是受造者,由一群<mark>有罪的人</mark>组成的。

- God works in the church, but the church is not God.
- God is the Creator, and the church is the created, made up of a group of sinful people.

• <mark>教会</mark>依靠神存在,需要全心仰赖神, 并等待祂的最后救赎。

 The church relies on God for its existence, needs to wholeheartedly depend on God, and awaits His final redemption.

教会的诞生 The Birth of the Church

41-42节

- ·「于是领受他(彼得)话的人就受了洗。那一天,门徒约添了三千人,都恒心遵守使徒的教训,彼此交接,擘饼,祈祷。」
- Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.

教会的特征 Characteristics of the Church

- 恒心遵守使徒的教训,彼此很好的交流与分享、举行圣餐和祈祷,是全心跟随耶稣基督的人。
- Persevering in the teachings of the apostles, having good communication and sharing with one another, partaking in the Lord's Supper, and praying are the characteristics of those who follow Jesus Christ wholeheartedly.

- 我们需要委身安定于一个教会,因为只有我们在教会里面才能获得整体生命的满足。
- We need to commit and settle in a church because it is only within the church that we can find the satisfaction of our entire life.



44-45节

- 「信的人都在一处, 凡物公用。并且卖了田产家业、照各人所需用的分给各人。」
- All the believers were together and had everything in common. Selling their possessions and goods, they gave to anyone as he had need.

完整团契 Intimate fellowship


46-47节

- · 「他们天天同心合意恒切的在殿里, 且在家中擘饼,存着欢喜诚实的心用 饭,赞美神,得众民的喜爱。」
- Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, raising God and enjoying the favor of all the people.

同心敬拜 Worship in unity

46-47节

- 「主将得救的人,天天加给他们。」
- And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.



- · 教会一定可以成为非 常美好的属灵大家庭
- The church can certainly become a wonderful spiritual family

约翰一书 1 John 1:3

- 我们将所看见、所听见的传给你们, 使你们与我们相交。我们乃是与父并 他儿子耶稣基督相交的。
- We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ.

约翰一书 1 John 1:7

- 我们若在光明中行,如同 神在光明中,就彼此相交,他儿子耶稣的血也洗净我们一切的罪。
- But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

- 教会是神的殿,是神工作的地方。基督徒只有委身在教会里,和教会弟兄姐妹一起生活,才可能真正认识教会,以及教会的工作。
- The church is God's temple, the place where God works. Christians can truly understand the church and its work only by dedicating themselves to the church and living together with fellow brothers and sisters in the church.

- 基督徒不只要委身基督, 也要委身教会。
- · 要成为基督徒,第一步是相信耶稣,第二步是加入并委身教会。第一个决定带来**救恩**,第二个决定带来团契生活。
- Christians are called to commit not only to Christ but also to the church.
- To become a Christian, the first step is to believe in Jesus, and the second step is to join and commit to the church.
 The first decision brings salvation, and the second decision brings fellowship life.

- 新约圣经提到"<mark>彼此</mark>"或"<mark>互相</mark>"超过50次,包括我们要彼此相爱、彼此代祷、彼此鼓励、彼此劝勉、彼此服事、彼此教导、彼此接纳、彼此荣耀、彼此担当、彼此饶恕、彼此顺服等。
- The New Testament mentions "one another" or "each other" more than 50 times, including commands to love one another, pray for one another, encourage one another, exhort one another, serve one another, teach one another, accept one another, glorify one another, bear one another's burdens, forgive one another, and submit to one another, among others.

以弗所书 Ephesians 4:16

- 全身都靠他联络得合式,百节各按各职,照着各体的功用彼此相助,便叫身体渐渐增长,在爱中建立自己。
- From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.

有个调查:美国的教会

A survey: American churches

- 只有 10 %的会友活跃
- 有 50 %的会友无意服事任何事工
- · 40 %的会友表示有心服事,但从未有人邀请他们服事,他们不知道要怎么做
- Only 10% of the members are active.
- 50% of the members have no intention to serve in any ministry.
- 40% of the members express a willingness to serve, but have never been invited to serve, and they don't know how to do it.

- 大部分的教会对于"积极会员"的 期望就是按时固定参加聚会,并在 财务上支持教会。
- Most churches' expectations for "active members" are simply attending regular meetings and providing financial support to the church.

结论 Conclusion

- · 我们参与和委身教会,不仅是为了自己的灵命长进,也是为别人的需要而贡献自己。只有这样,我们才可以让基督的身体渐渐成长,使神国更快在地上实现。
