




2) 拿因城寡妇的儿子, 是在送殡时复活

Lazarus was resurrected after being dead for four days




7个记号/神迹 seven signs (miracles):

- 1) 变水为酒 Turning water into wine (二1-11)
- 2) 医大臣之子 The official's son (四46-54)
- 3) 医38年病患者 The man who had been sick for 38 years (五1-9)
- 4) 给五千人吃饱 Feeding five thousand people (六1-14)
- 5) 行走海面 Walking on water (六16-21)
- 6) 医治瞎子 Healing a blind man (九1-7)
- 7)使拉撒路复活 Raising Lazarus from the dead (十一1-44)


一、耶稣就是复活、就是生命 Jesus is the resurrection and the life

7个我是 seven 'l am' statements:

- 1) 我是生命的粮"I am the bread of life"
- 2) 世界的光"I am the light of the world"
- 3) 羊的门"I am the gate for the sheep"
- 4) 好牧人"I am the good shepherd"
- 5) 复活和生命"I am the resurrection and the life"
- 6) 道路、真理、生命"I am the way, the truth, and the life"
- 7) 真葡萄树"I am the true vine"




- · (4节) 耶稣听见就说: "这病不至于死,乃 是为神的荣耀,叫神的儿子因此得荣耀。"

- On his arrival, Jesus found that Lazarus had already been in the tomb for four days.




- · (39节)那死人的姐姐马大对他说: "主啊, 他现在必是臭了,因为他死了已经四天了。"
- "But, Lord," said Martha, the sister of the dead man, "by this time there is a bad odor, for he has been there four days."






Martha answered, "I know he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day."

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." John 14:6






· (32节)马利亚到了耶稣那里,看见他,就俯伏在他脚前,说:"主啊,你若早在这里,我兄弟必不死。"




 When Mary reached the place where Jesus was and saw him, she fell at his feet and said, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died."



Jesus Christ came to earth, triumphed over the power of sin, conquered death, and rose again to heaven. Everyone who believes in Jesus can share in this victory.






我们与神建立新关系 We establish a new relationship with God
