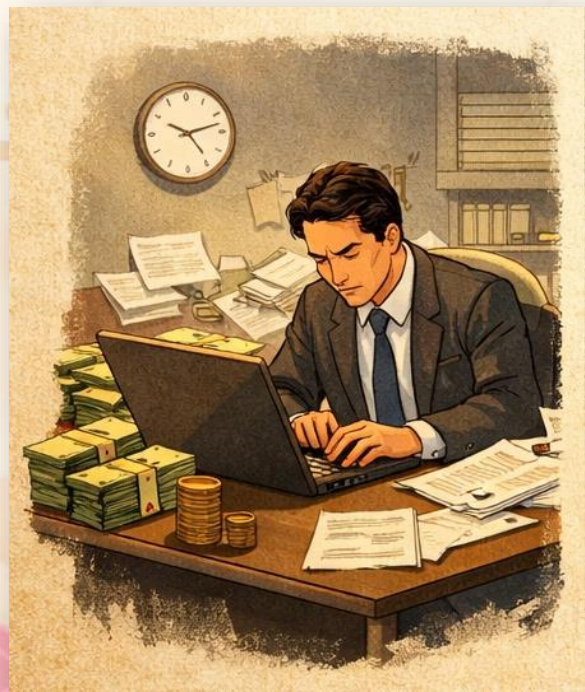

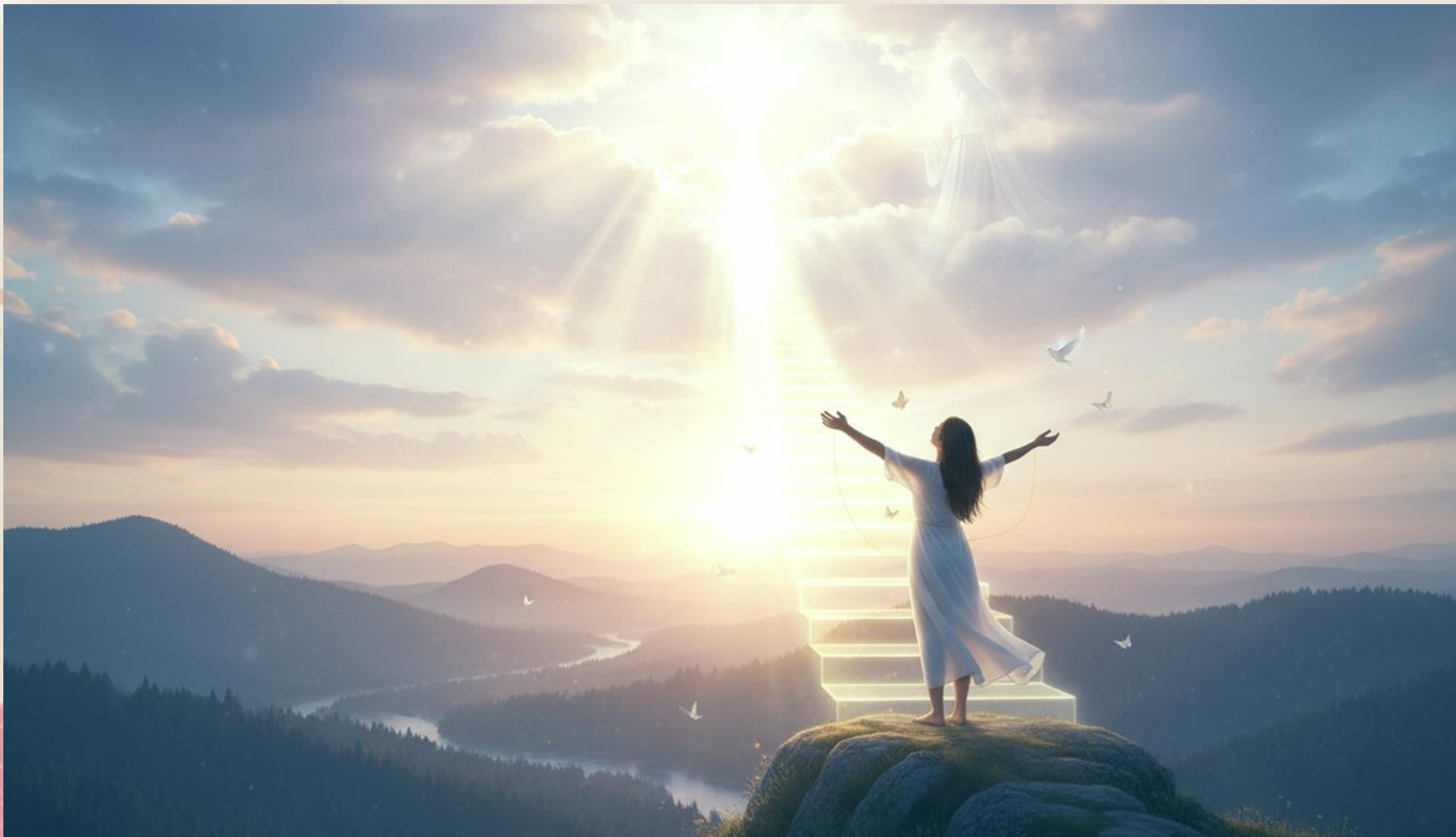

- 'Though the fig tree does not bud and there are no grapes on the vines, though the olive crop fails and the fields produce no food... yet I will rejoice in the Lord, I will be joyful in God my Savior.'

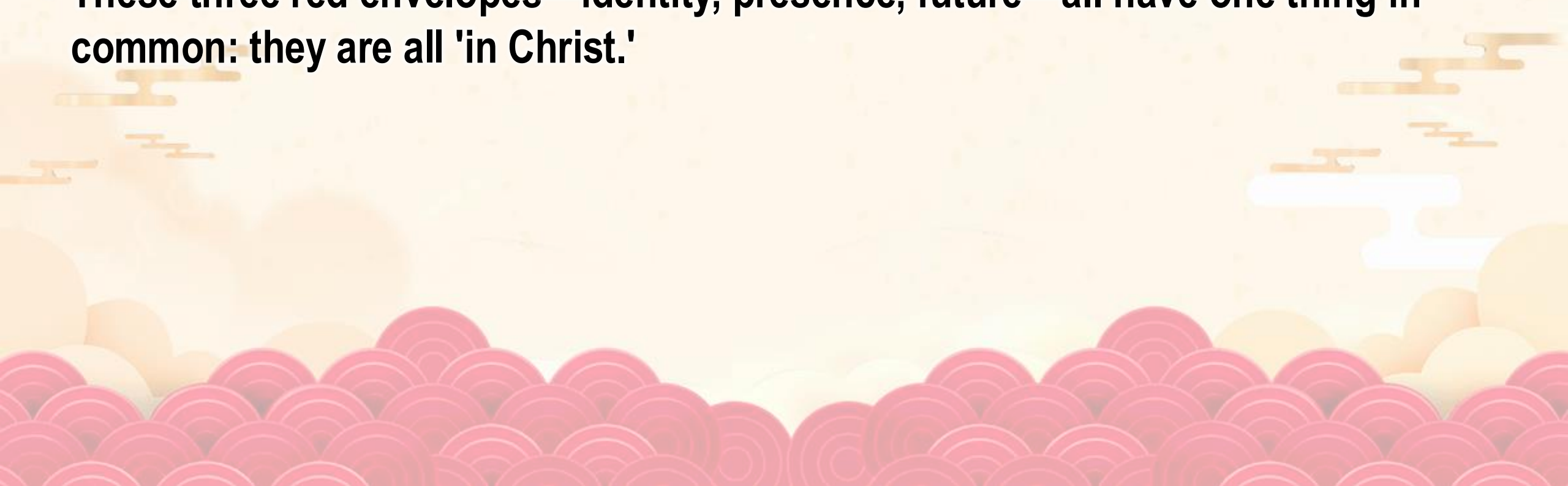
人的红包用完就没了，但神的产业是永远的。

- Many will say: In the Year of the Horse, we must run, move forward quickly, and "achieve immediate success."
- 但圣经提醒我们：问题不是你跑得多快，而是——你往哪里跑？
- But the Bible reminds us: The issue is not how fast you run, but—where are you running?

总结 Conclusion

希伯来书 Hebrews 12:1-2

- 我们既然有这许多的见证人如同云彩围着我们，就当放下各样的重担，脱去容易缠累我们的罪，存心忍耐，奔那摆在我们前面的路程，仰望为我们信心创始成终的耶稣。”
- “Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, fixing our eyes on Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith.”

总结 Conclusion

- 这一年，我们不是盲目地奔跑——不是只追求升职、金钱、成就，而是向着耶稣奔跑，知道自己为谁而活，也知道人生的终点在哪里。
- This year, we are not running blindly—not just pursuing promotions, money, achievements, but running toward Jesus, knowing who we live for, and knowing where the end of life is.
